Unlike most national charities, Assistance League of Tustin's focus is directly on our local community. All funds we raise "go to work" right within our city in places where funding is needed most. And linked together with all of our chapters nationwide, the Assistance League works day-in-and-out, in a variety of different ways, to help those in need achieve a better quality of life.





Caring and Commitment in action!

Assistance League of Tustin is an autonomous, tax-exempt charitable corporation with over 300 member-volunteers. We consist of our Chapter members who professionally run the organization along with two auxiliaries: our Winifred Campbell Auxiliary, for women who work full-time or prefer to meet in the evenings; and our Assisteens, an incredibly-active group of nearly 150 caring young women and men in grades 8–12. Together, last year these three groups celebrated over 20,000 hours of volunteerism in the community of Tustin.

The power to make a difference.

Our chapter gains it's strength not only from our dedicated volunteers, but from the support and revenues that come directly from donor contributions and other fund-raising efforts including operation of our Thrift Shop and special events. ALT's current philanthropic activities include the following programs in the community of Tustin:

Operation School Bell®

Hundreds of students in the Tustin Unified School District (TUSD) receive new school-approved uniforms, a variety of school supplies, and a voucher to buy shoes through this valuable program.



Children's Dental Health

Each fall, students who would otherwise be unable to seek dental care are screened by local dentists right at their own elementary school. Each child is given a written report to take home to their parents, along with a toothbrush and toothpaste. Those who are



identified as being in need of urgent dental care receive funding from ALT and contributions from local participating dentists for treatment at one of their reputable offices.

Project Today

This drug and alcohol program is offered in partnership with TUSD to middle- and highschool students after they have been suspended for first-time possession or use of these substances. Intervention and education programs are included, and parents are given the tools to recognize symptoms and respond when their children are at risk of substance abuse.

S.A.T. Preparation Classes

Provides facilities and instructors for high school students to assist them in preparation for the Scholastic Aptitude Test for college entrance. Qualified teachers in the fields of English and Mathematics instruct at these sessions with guidance and supervision by appropriate personnel.

Waste Not, Want Not

Provides secondary clothing and merchandise to Deseret Industries, UCI Medical Center, and other unrelated not-for-profit entities. These items are initially received as donations to the ALT thrift shop.

Hearts of Hope

Oversees the distribution of food and provides assistance to shelters in the Tustin community including: The Village of Hope, Mary's Shelter, and the Laurel House. These organizations provide shelter for homeless families, singles, or pregnant teens or other teenagers having difficulties at home.

Assisteens® Buddy Program

This innovative program provides service and support to AYSO, Blind Children's Learning Center and Aquachievers Swim Program through Blue Buoy Swim School by partnering Assisteens with children and adults who have special needs.

Outdoor Education

Provides jackets, sleeping bags, boots, and other camping gear to local elementary school children to use during their outdoor education program which is run by elementary schools in the Tustin Unified School District.

Every 15 Minutes

ALT makes a contribution to the local school district annually to assist with the funding of this district-run program that emphasizes the results of driving under the influence.
